THE FOLLOWING IS THE MUNICIPALITIES' PRESENTATION

Danville

A little piece of paradise located in between Sherbrooke, Victoriaville and Drummondville. It is considered one of the most picturesque villages in all of the Eastern Townships. Danville invites you on a surprising journey through its history, with its architecture and its dynamic vision for a promising future. With its industrial park, daycare center, elementary schools, wide range of recreational activities and numerous services, Danville offers an exceptional living and working environment.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Le Centre d'interprétation de l'Étang Burbank for bird watching or wandering in nature;
 - The Symposium des arts de Danville and its many art galleries;
 - La Mante du Carré which is both a public market and a restaurant;
 - The architectural heritage of the houses, a mixture of French and English culture;
 - For cycling enthusiasts, a 14 km section of La Route verte crosses the MRC des Sources from Saint-Cyr to Kingsey Station, passing through Danville, where you will find the tourist information office.

Ham-Sud

Ham-Sud is a charming municipality dedicated to tourism, agriculture and forestry located on the borders of the Eastern Townships in the MRC des Sources and the Bois-Francs. A magnificent place to watch the sunsets and wander in nature, Ham-Sud is in full expansion to revitalize its environment and meet the needs of its citizens, from the youngest to the oldest.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- A true paradise for nature lovers, the Mont Ham Regional Park with its 713 meters of altitude reveals a breathtaking view of the surroundings;
- The Camping du Mont Ham-Sud, located on the shores of Lac à la Truite, offers several activities, including a perfect environment for fishing enthusiasts;
- The eco-residential project: Au pied du Mont-Ham, which carries out innovative projects of a sustainable nature, in order to build a

- community with ecological values and implement an efficient management model for the members of the cooperative.
- The parks: The Recreation Park with numerous play modules for children and the Senior's Park with picnic areas surrounded by fruit trees and shrubs.
 - The peaceful accommodations: the [l'Auberge-restaurant la Mara](#), the Chambre d'hôtes La Grande Dame, the cottage rental Au pied du mont Ham or at Miel et terre.

Saint-Adrien

The charm of Saint-Adrien lies in the people who live there and work for its development and quality of life. It is a haven of tranquility, charm, fresh air and vitality, the ideal living environment for young families. It is home to friendly and welcoming people who are proud of their roots and their environment. The adriennais community is vibrant with initiative and creativity. All it takes is one visit to persuade!

HIGHLIGHTS:

- The multifunctional performance hall, [La Meunerie](#), which thrives in large part thanks to the volunteer involvement of the people of the village;
 - The company [Projet 1606](#), which has converted the church into a community gathering place and is the head office of BEAM (Bureau Estrien de l'Audiovisuel et du Multimédia);
 - [BEAM](#) is an organization that brings people together and promotes the development of creative businesses. It offers equipment and recording studio rentals, as well as support services for national and international audiovisual productions;
 - [Comptoir St-Vrac](#), a regenerative grocery store that empowers its community.

Saint-Camille

In a magnificent hilly landscape, at the head of the Nicolet River watershed, Saint-Camille is one of the most flourishing villages in Quebec. The municipality is full of ideas and team spirit. It is a place that constantly renews itself, driven by a community that is vibrant, innovative and always looking forward.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- The family trail, which offers 6 kilometers of walking paths dotted with interpretation panels;
 - Located in the old general store, Le P'tit Bonheur shines with its performance hall, café, art gallery, rural interpretation center and Friday pizza;
 - The Centre Le Camillois, managed by Destination Saint-Camille, is a convention center located in the heart of the village, a former church which is now converted into a multifunctional center;
 - The Saint-Antoine Sanctuary is an important heritage building for the community. It is a place to discover!

Saint-Georges-de-Windsor

Saint-Georges-de-Windsor has the family at its core as well as the desire to cultivate its land and its traditions. Located in the heights of the region of des Sources, this municipality provides breathtaking scenery and a safe and warm living environment. The village church protects an exceptionally rich cultural heritage, as does the legend of the dragons of Saint-Georges, which is believed to be the origin of the village's foundation.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Sport and Leisure Committee along with citizen involvement facilitates all kinds of activities throughout the seasons in the village;
 - The excellent cheese of La Fromagerie Proulx which, at the beginning of the 40's, sent cheddar wheels to England to feed the troops who were fighting in the Second World War;
 - La halte des Horizons, a roadside rest area, which includes a unique observatory and a small tourist kiosk.

Val-des-Sources

Val-des-Sources is the city at the center of the region of des Sources. A place where the population has access to government, administrative, commercial, health and recreational services. Founded in 1899, Val-des-Sources (formerly Asbestos) is shaped by a rich mining history, one of the vestiges of which is a huge open pit mine, today overlooked by an observatory accessible to the general public, creating a unique place in Quebec. An ideal place for families.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Moulin 7 Microbrewery to explore new flavors in an atmosphere influenced by our mining roots;
 - The Centre O3 and its music camp which is among the most recognized in Quebec;
 - The Royal Estrie Golf Club with its remarkably beautiful site and a reception hall that can accommodate up to 500 people.

Wotton

With its curious and talented community, Wotton has more than one string to its bow. Surrounded by rolling hills and farmland, the village is a tight knit community that never hesitates to help each other excel. Wotton is a prosperous agricultural municipality, proud of its French-Canadian origins and of its pioneers, the first owners freed from the lordships of Lower Canada. Its artisanal productions and its tasty gastronomy make it a pleasant place to live, based on family values and the protection of our nourishing land.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Camping de la rivière Nicolet offers activities for the whole family, such as the Enchanted Forest adventure game or tubing down the river;
 - La Maison Grise Cheese Factory where you can visit the goats, buy cheese (they even have cheese curds!) and find products from local producers and artists;
 - Les Miels Lambert, a honey factory that started nearly 50 years ago and is now one of the largest honey producers in Quebec;
 - The maple park with its forest trails accessible all year long.

Family

In the Region of des Sources, family life is a priority. Several actions are taken to help reconcile family-work-study-caregiving. In this region, these include:

- A safe living environment with a community spirit;
- Educational methods based on non-violence and a human approach;
- The proximity to nature which makes it an ideal place for the young and old to blossom;
- Health services for the whole family.

DAYCARE CENTERS

The Region of des Sources has three daycare centers, an ecological daycare center in Saint-Georges-de-Windsor, a multitude of private settings as well as two drop-in daycare centers through La Maison des Familles FamillAction.

SENIORS' SERVICES

Some of our municipalities are part of the Senior Friendly Municipalities (MADA) program which aims to encourage active aging of seniors within their community. Thus, initiatives are taken in our communities to improve the quality of life of seniors.

We also have the Culture aux aînés, project, led by the *P'tit bonheur* de Saint-Camille, which aims at the social participation of seniors through artistic and social activities to improve their well-being.
